The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Cushman, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated September 24, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.
