City of Washington, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Washington, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2024, and have issued our report thereon dated October 7, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

The City has not obtained an audit or agreed-upon procedures and compilation report for the City's Water Department for 2023, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-234-119. The City has signed an engagement letter dated May 30, 2025.
