Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Garner, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Garner, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated June 13, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Fire Department and Sewer Department. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2024 and 2023:

Mayor: Dana Wilcox (appointed December 1, 2023)
Dorothy Hanner (deceased November 13, 2023)

Recorder/Treasurer: Carla Johnson

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer.

Mayor

An audit or agreed-upon procedures report and compilation has not been completed for the Sewer Fund, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-234-119.

Recorder/Treasurer

A fixed asset listing was established but not updated to include all purchases as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-107. In addition, a fixed asset policy has not been adopted by the governing body. A similar finding was noted in the previous report.

Adequate supporting documentation was not maintained for credit card transactions tested totaling \$1,031 in 2023, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-105. Subsequently, the Town was able to obtain appropriate documentation that supported a business purpose.

The City made payments to the City Attorney totaling \$3,300 annually in 2024 and 2023 without adequate supporting documentation in the form of an authorizing ordinance or contract, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-105.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
