Additionally, we requested certain cash basis information and your acknowledgement of compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the years ended December 31, 2023, and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated July 9, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.
