We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Tupelo, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2024, and have issued our report thereon dated June 30, 2025. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Recorder/Treasurer.

#### Recorder/Treasurer

The cash receipts and disbursements journals were not properly posted and classified, as required by Ark. Code Ann. §§ 14-59-110, -111.
